



## WINCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT QUICK GUIDE

**Q. Will we return to school at the same date?  
Will there be different hours I will be at  
school?**

A. The school year will begin as scheduled on September 6<sup>th</sup> and there will be no change to the hours.

**Q. What can I expect when I return to school?**

A. Construction activities will be in full swing and will be isolated to the A and B - Wing. The newly renovated E and C wings will now be ready for use. The new bank of 20 Modular Classrooms has been added adjacent to the Gym.

**Q. How will I know where the construction zone  
is?**

A. On the interior of the building the construction zone will be separated from the school by walls. On the exterior of the building a chain link fence will delineate where the construction zone is and signs will be in place.

**Q. Will I be allowed to be in the construction  
area at any time?**

A. No, walls on the interior and fences on the exterior will separate the school and construction areas. Keeping you safe is of the highest importance so because of this students will not be allowed to be in the construction zone.



**Q. How will I know what is going on in the construction zone?**

A. The project website ([www.winchesterhsproject.com](http://www.winchesterhsproject.com)) will be updated throughout the year with progress updates as well as photos to keep the students up to date on progress.

**Q. Will the construction be noisy? How will I be able to focus?**

A. Minimizing disruption is a top goal of the project. Interior walls are being designed to limit the amount of noise that can come through. With these in place you should not have any issues focusing on your important school work. However, should you have any concerns in regards to noise you should contact Principal Mahoney or staff.

**Q. Will I enter the school at the same location I always have?**

A. The front entrance will remain in the same location as last year directly off of Skillings Road. The entrance at the rear of the school will be through E and C Wing

**Q. If I take the bus where will I be dropped off?**

A. You will still be dropped off at the front of the school at the new entrance.

**Q. If I walk will there be any changes?**

A. The only difference will be that you will not be able to cut through the drive lane and old staff



parking lot adjacent to A and B wing as these will be in the construction zone

**Q. If I ride a bike will there be any place for me to lock it?**

A. Yes, bike racks will be provided close to the entrance of the school.

**Q. If I get dropped off will my parents go to the same location?**

A. Yes, parent drop off will be at the front entrance drive.

**Q. If I drive will I be able to park in the same location?**

A. There will be no onsite campus student parking for Phase 3 of the construction project. Students are encouraged to walk/bike or carpool. Those students who do drive there will be parking at Borggaard Beach with overflow parking at the cemetery, however, space is limited.

**Q. Will there be the same amount of student parking?**

A. There will not be any onsite campus parking for Phase 3

**Q. Can I parking in the neighborhood behind the High School?**

A. No, students will not be allowed to park in the neighborhood behind the High School.
